

SUBJECT: Policy Letter # 39-01, Installation Point of Contact for Family Advocacy Matters

1. The Directorate of Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (DMWR) Army Community Service (ACS) assists commanders by providing accessible and complementary activities and service, as well as a variety of training and support programs. The ACS is the agency responsible for the overall management of the Family Advocacy Program (FAP). The FAP Manager (FAPM) administers and directs the installation on family advocacy matters and is the installation commander's primary representative and subject matter expert on child and spouse abuse.
2. In accordance with Paragraph 2-1, AR 608-18, the Family Advocacy Program, all matters concerning administration, management, prevention, and direct services of FAP will be directed through the FAPM. All requests for training in domestic violence will be coordinated through the FAP.
