3. <b>CRITICAL:</b> The barracks are properly ventilated and heating temperatures are controlled. (AR 40-5, Para 12-7; FM 8-250, Para 19-2).	CO			
4. <b>CRITICAL:</b> The overall sanitary quality of the barracks is satisfactory including insect and rodent control guidelines. (AR 40-5, Para 12-7; FM 8-250, Para 19-2).	CO			
5. Unserviceable furniture is being replaced. (i.e. mattresses) (AR 40-5, Para 12-7).	CO			
<b>Permanent Party</b>				
1. <b>CRITICAL:</b> The latrines and shower facilities are cleaned and in good repair. (AR 40-5, Para 12-7).	CO			
2. <b>CRITICAL:</b> The overall sanitary quality of the barracks is satisfactory including insect and rodent control. a. Food is kept in covered/sealed containers. b. All openings to the outside are sealed. c. Waste receptacles are covered and emptied daily. (AR 40-5, Para 12-7).	CO			
3. <b>CRITICAL:</b> The soldiers are prescribed 72 square feet of floor space which includes maintaining the maximum distance between bunks possible. (AR 40-5, Para 12-7; FM 8-250, Para 5-8)	CO
