The standard is "T"= Brigade has 16 or more GO's or Battalion has 14 or more GO's; with no failed critical tasks; "P"= Brigade has 13 or more GO's or Battalion has 11 or more GO's with no failed critical tasks; "U"= Brigade has 12 or less GO's or Battalion has 10 or less GO's or one failed critical task.
