**STANDARDS:** There are 17 Tasks. The standard is “T” if 15 or more GOs with no failed critical tasks are achieved; “P” if 12 or more GOs with no failed critical tasks; and “U” if 11 or less GOs or one failed critical task.

7. <b>CRITICAL:</b> Is the leader development program focused at unit level (FM 7-0, Para. 1-23 thru 1-26)?	CG/CMDT			
8. <b>CRITICAL:</b> Is the leader development program driven by the METL and the professional development needs of the unit's junior leaders (FM 7-0, Para. 1-31)?	CG/CMDT
