

TAKE A BRIEF TOUR

Welcome to Indiana Avenue Housing.



Indiana Avenue Housing consists of converted family housing units to include duplexes, four-plexes, six-plexes, and eight-plexes. Each housing unit has two, three, or four private bedrooms. Shared common areas include living room, kitchen, laundry facilities, and bathrooms (determined by the number of bedrooms in the unit). There is “front door” parking, however it is limited and utilized on a first come, first serve basis. These facilities were constructed in the early 1960s. There is currently a project underway to renovate approximately half of the buildings and demolish the remaining buildings upon completion of twenty-four additional new UEPH buildings.

While these facilities are older, they have been maintained fairly well for their age. There are generally additional closets within the unit that equate to one additional storage closet for each occupant. In addition, some units have storage sheds behind them that may be signed for by an occupant for additional storage. The facilities also are equipped with safety equipment, i.e. smoke detector, CO2 detector, and fire extinguishers. Each housing unit is two stories with the bedrooms and a bathroom on the second floor. A few of the four bedroom units have one bedroom downstairs. These facilities will have two or two and a half bathrooms, one upstairs and the other(s) downstairs.

Our single Service Members seem to enjoy the large common areas in these facilities despite their age. In addition, Indiana Avenue has a basketball court and newly installed pavilions located around the facilities that will be renovated. Other improvements have been or are scheduled to be accomplished in the near future.

Welcome to our New UEPH Housing



The new UEPH Housing at Fort Leonard Wood is unlike any other in the Army. It is being constructed (began in 2006) in increments with the first three increments completed and the fourth slated for later FY11. Each building consists of four two-man units and one NCO unit. The NCO unit is the ground unit without a second story above it. As you can see, it allows parking at the curb in front of your assigned unit, one space per occupant. Occupants enjoy private bedroom, walk in closet, and lavatory area. Shared common areas include kitchen, laundry facilities, and bathroom.
