To help us keep our community looking its best during the fall lawn mowing season, we ask that you remember a few things:

- Residents are asked to pick up any personal property & trash in the yard prior to your scheduled lawn mowing. In order to protect our resident's personal property, Yardmasters will leave a 2' perimeter around any item left in the yard. If there are too many decorations or toys left out on mowing day, Yardmasters will not mow your lawn.
- Satellite or Cable TV cables are required to be buried in the yard. If your cable is not buried and is damaged by a mower, the cost of the repair will be the Resident's responsibility. A 1' perimeter will be left around any satellite dish that is installed in the yard. It is our Resident's responsibility to trim around any satellite dish.
- Residents are asked to pick up after their pets daily. Yards that are not picked up will not be mowed. As a safety precaution to the employees of Yardmaster and our Residents, no leashes or dog chains can be left in the yard.
- Homes with a fenced yard are required to be maintained by the Resident on a weekly basis. In the event of a deployment, please provide your Community Center with a copy of the deployment orders and we will gladly add your fenced in area to our weekly schedule.
- For our Residents who would like to mow their own yards, please visit your Community Center to pick up a "do not mow" sign. Residents displaying the sign are required to be mowed and trimmed on a weekly basis.
