- Interactive tool designed to allow members to rate, comment and suggest other resources
- Supports a collaborative learning environment

The purpose of the Resource Menu is to vertically nest with strategic and MSCoE guidance, progressively build upon attributes and competencies throughout a career, and integrate horizontally among the three learning domains (institutional, operational, and self). The Resource Menu is a paradigm shift from a reading list which operates solely within the self domain.

The Resource Menu operates in the overlap of the three domains and is to be equally useful to an individual as to an operational leader or institutional programs of instructions.
