58th Transportation Battalion Lineage

Constituted 1 May 1936 in the Regular Army as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 2d Battalion, 27th Quartermaster Regiment

Activated 25 July 1942 at Camp Rucker, Alabama, as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 2d Battalion, 27th Quartermaster Truck Regiment

Reorganized and redesignated 28 October 1943 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 58th Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile

Inactivated 1 October 1945 in Italy

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 58th Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Redesignated 15 November 1965 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 58th Transportation Battalion, and activated at Fort Benning, Georgia

Inactivated 29 April 1972 at Oakland Army Air Base, California

Headquarters transferred 15 July 1986 to the United States Army Training and Doctrine Command and activated at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri
