Course Descriptions

Satellite Accumulation Point (SAP) Course

The 4-hour SAP course teaches proper hazardous waste management procedures for the operation of a satellite accumulation point. This training is required by state and federal law and must be updated annually. SAP training is only available to personnel that are assigned to a unit with an operational SAP.

Environmental Compliance Officer (ECO) Course

Personnel trained in this 28-hour course serve as advisors to the commander/director on environmental matters. Training of the ECO will include a working knowledge of federal, state and local laws, Army regulations and policies and “how to” aspects of environmental duties. FLW Reg 200-1 requires commanders for each command, directorate, brigade, and tenant activity on Fort Leonard Wood to appoint and train an ECO. It is highly recommended that ECOs be appointed at company level.
