


# Spill Prevention and Response





# Enabling Learning Objective

- **ACTION:** Employ Spill Prevention and Response Plan (SPRP) Procedures
- **CONDITION:** In a classroom environment, using information presented in Title 40 CFR Parts 110-112, 40 CFR Parts 262-280, AR 200-1 and Title 25 CSR Part 260-270
- **STANDARD:** Students will:
  - ✓ Identify responsibilities IAW FLW SPRP
  - ✓ Identify spill prevention activities
  - ✓ Identify the six steps to spill response






# SPRP Responsibilities

- SPRP (available at [www.wood.army.mil/DPWENV](http://www.wood.army.mil/DPWENV)) is required to be posted at all locations where Hazardous Material/Waste (HM/HW) and Petroleum, Oils, and Lubricants (POLs) are handled/stored.
- Provides responsibilities and procedures in the event of HM/HW/POL spill.
- Site specific training should include:
  - ✓ evacuation routes
  - ✓ special information unique to the site
  - ✓ recall numbers for unit personnel





# SPRP Responsibilities (continued)

- Maintain a copy of the SPRP and a list of emergency phone numbers at each site.
- Appoint members to a spill response team, if needed under Site Specific Plans.
- Train & ensure personnel are familiar with the SPRP procedures, roles, and responsibilities.





# Spill Response

## Action Phase

- Six Basic Steps:
  - ✓ Protect yourself
  - ✓ Stop the flow
  - ✓ Report the spill (911)
  - ✓ Contain the spill
  - ✓ Clean the spill
  - ✓ Restock materials





# SPRP Responsibilities continued

- **ALL** spills must be **IMMEDIATELY** reported to the Fire Department at 911.
- Stop the flow and contain the spill if possible.
- Spills will be cleaned by facility occupants. If manpower is unavailable, contact the DPW Contractor 573/596-0333.





# SPRP Responsibilities (continued)

- Spills must be reported IAW the SPRP.
  - ✓ SPRP includes the report form, which requires:
    - Type of material
    - Quantity
    - Location
    - Duration
    - Cause
    - Other Special Information
  - ✓ Submit written spill report within **3 days** of incident to the DPW Environmental Office.





# Spill Response (continued)

## Post Spill Actions

- Complete Spill Report form and submit within three days to FLW DPW Environmental.
- Plan for preventing recurrence:
  - ✓ Determine cause of spill
  - ✓ Develop new SOPs if necessary
- Replace spill clean up equipment and supplies.
