

Littlewood Pond

Impoundment Rules and Regulations

Littlewood Pond is located within the cantonment..

Littlewood Pond is accessible 24 hours/day, 7 days/week.

All persons must remain within 50 feet of the shoreline, designated access trails, roads, or parking areas associated with the impoundment.

Any person recreating (excluding hunting and trapping) must leave the area immediately upon the request of Range Control or Game Wardens.

Fishing is restricted to persons who are fifteen (15) years of age or younger, and not more than one (1) pole and line may be used by any one person at one time.

A Fort Leonard Wood Sportsman's Permit is required. Missouri residents fifteen (15) years of age or younger will receive one (1) Sportsman's Permit free of charge at the Outdoor Adventure Center (<http://www.fortleonardwoodmwr.com/outdoor.php>).

Vehicle use is restricted to graveled and paved roads and parking areas only.

Boats are allowed (no gasoline-powered motors may be used).

Bullfrogs and green frogs may be taken during the statewide season only by hand, hand net, gig, snagging, snaring, grabbing, or pole and line.

Netting or trapping of live bait is prohibited.

Fishing is prohibited where designated by signs.

Daily catch limits:

- Frogs - **eight (8)**
- Black bass - **one (1)**
- Channel catfish of any size - **one (1)**
- Crappie of any size - **five (5)**
- Fish of any size (other than black bass, channel catfish, and crappie) - **five (5)**

Posted regulations are IAW Fort Leonard Wood regulation 210-21-5a-f and the Missouri Wildlife Code.

Driving directions to Littlewood Pond from The Outdoor Adventure Center, FLW K, (573)-596-4223.

1. Travel west on FLW K to FLW 10 for 0.5 miles and turn right.
2. Continue on FLW 10/1st Street for 1.1 miles to Nebraska Ave and turn right.
3. Continue on Nebraska Ave for 0.1 miles and pond will be on your right.
