

Roubidoux Creek

Rules and Regulations

Access to Roubidoux creek from the low water crossing on FLW 8 to the installation boundary near Polla Road is the **ONLY** section accessible 24 hours/day, 7 days/week.

Access to all other locations along Roubidoux Creek is controlled by **Hunting Area Status**.

Any person wishing to fish the restricted sections of Roubidoux Creek must first check the daily **Open Hunting Area Announcement by calling 573-596-4224**.

Roubidoux Creek flows through several hunting areas. If the desired Hunting Area is open, **a person must physically check in at Range Control (Bldg 5282) or by email through the FLW Hunting and Fishing website <http://www.wood.army.mil/dptm/handf.htm> and be issued a Hunting Area Access Pass**. Registration must be completed on the same day access is desired.

Fishing rules, including seasons, daily limits, and length limits are specified in the Missouri Wildlife Code: <http://www.sos.mo.gov/adrules/csr/current/3csr/3csr.asp>

A Missouri Fishing Permit is required except for Missouri residents who are sixty-five (65) years of age or older, and any person who is fifteen (15) years of age or younger. A Missouri Fishing Permit may be purchased online at: <https://mdc.mo.gov/>

A Fort Leonard Wood Sportsman's Permit is required and can be purchased through the Outdoor Adventure Center (<http://www.fortleonardwoodmwr.com/outdoor.php>). Missouri residents who are sixty-five (65) years of age or older, and any person who is fifteen (15) years of age or younger will receive one (1) Sportsman's Permit free of charge at the Outdoor Adventure Center.
