


Everybody wins When We Recycle at Fort Leonard Wood


FORT LEONARD WOOD

FLW manages recyclables through the **Qualified Recycling Program (QRP)** and utilizes various collection initiatives

Where To Drop Off Your Recyclables

The Recycling Center offers **3 drop off areas** that are available **24 hours per day**.

- 1) * The primary collection on FLW is at the Recycling Center located at Building #2549 Ordnance Drive
- 2) * Main PX parking lot - drop off bins
- 3) * Commissary/Mini Mall parking lot-drop off bins



What You Can Recycle

	Aluminum Recycling: aluminum cans and clean foil.
	Paper Recycling: White paper, Cardboard, corrugated boxes, paperboard (shoe cereal & soda boxes), shipping cartons, brown envelopes & manila folders, junk mail, magazines, colored paper & phone books-small amounts of staples are ok.
	Plastic bottles (soft drink, single-use water bottles, sport drinks), clean food jars, cosmetic containers
	Detergent bottles, milk and juice jugs
	Medicine bottles, plastic caps, syrup bottles.
	baby bottles, water cooler bottles, ketchup bottles
*	Steel and tin cans
*	GLASS- green, clear and brown.
