# Snow & Ice Removal Program (SNAIR)



## Road Condition Standards and Safety Actions

### Road Condition Colors:

**GREEN:** No Restrictions, normal speed limits

**AMBER:** Safe speed is 10 MPH BELOW posted speed limit

**RED:** Safe speed is much greater than 10 MPH BELOW posted speed limit; intersections very hazardous; slow down based on conditions and vehicle handling

**BLACK:** Emergency Vehicle Movement Only

### Safety Actions:

Unscheduled Leave: Supervisors grant leave to non mission-critical personnel

Curtailed Operations: Delayed Start Times or Early Release

Suspended Operations: Mission Critical Personnel Only

# Holiday Block Leave



## CDR INTENT:

Key Tasks: (1) Prepare and support all IMT service members for the HBL period, (2) Ensure personnel travel from FLW to their holiday destinations by the most efficient means possible. (3) Provide supervision and support to SMs that remain @ FLW during HBL (4) Rapidly reintegrate IMT Soldiers upon return from HBL.

**CONCEPT OF THE OPERATION:** This operation will be conducted in three phases (Preparation Phase, Departure and Holdover Operations, and Return Operations).

**PHASE I – Preparation:** This consists of ticketing operations and safety briefs ensuring IMT Soldiers understand requirements associated with movement and conduct during HBL period.

**PHASE II – Departure and Holdover Operations:** This consists of efforts to enable departure of all personnel departing FLW for the HBL period and support activities for personnel that remain on FLW during HBL.

**PHASE III – Return Operations:** This consists of efforts to enable return of all personnel to their training units and completion of mandatory post-HBL requirements.

**SITUATION:** MSCoE/FLW Trainees & Soldiers will participate in FY16 HBL OPS. MSCoE units implement multiple actions to ensure a safe and enjoyable holiday season for all.

**MISSION:** MSCoE/FLW conducts Holiday Block Leave operations to ensure all Initial Military Training (IMT) personnel prepare for, conduct, and return from the holiday period.

# Holiday Safety Awareness



- **Inspect electrical decorations for damage before use.** Cracked or damaged sockets, loose or bare wires, and loose connections may cause a serious shock or start a fire.
- **Do not overload electrical outlets.** Overloaded electrical outlets and faulty wires are a common cause of holiday fires.
- **Keep tree fresh by watering daily.** Dry trees are a serious fire hazard.
- **Stay in the kitchen when something is cooking.** Unattended cooking equipment is the leading cause of home cooking fires (NFPA).
- **Turn off, unplug, and extinguish all decorations when going to sleep or leaving the house.** Unattended candles are the cause of one in five home candle fires. Half of home fire deaths occur between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. (NFPA).



## Intervention: Be an ACE



### A: Ask

- Ask the question directly and stay calm, e.g. Are you thinking of killing yourself? Do you want to die (youth)? Do you wish you were dead?

### C: Care

- Remove any means that could be used for self-injury.
- Calmly control the situation; do not use force.
- Reassure that he or she will be helped.

### E: Escort

- Never leave your Family member or friend alone.
- Escort to the emergency room, primary care provider, or behavioral health professional.




