PROHIBITED ITEMS:			
Possession of the following items, at any time from the start, during, or upon completion of the course, will result in the immediate dis-enrollment and removal of the student from the course.			
Weapons (handguns, rifles, shotguns, bayonets, hunting knives, swords, martial arts weapons, bows, arrows, darts, or any item that could reasonably be construed to be a weapon, whether real, replica, air, for training, or a toy. Explosives, explosive components, accessories, or precursor elements of any Ammunition (live, dummy, or blank, or components/products to construct such) amount/type)			
NOTES:			
1. Belt, trousers	Tan only, issued or commercially purchased equivalent, rigger-type belt, with black buckle.		
2. Boots, pair	Tan desert boots only, after 30 April 2008. Civilian purchased boots, that meet guidance IAW the AR 670-1, are authorized for wear.		
3. Parka, wet weather	ACU only. Parka must OR Parka, ECWS have subdued rank attached if rank tab is attached. Pin-on subdued rank is currently authorized.		
4. Eye and ear protection	Any style goggles or glasses, with an ANZI/ANSI rating, with or without logos, issued or personally purchased, subdued in color.		
5. Class "A"/ ASU	The skirt or slacks may be worn as part of the Female uniform; All awards and decorations are mandatory for wear; ensure proper fit prior to attending course		
6. ACU Top	You must bring at least two complete sets of Name tags, US Flags, Unit Patches, rank. Wear of special skills badges and tabs are optional for wear.		
7. ACU Top & Bottom	You are not authorized to wear the fire resistant ACU's or A2CU's during this course		
8. Calculators	Construction calculators will not be permitted for use in the course
