FORT LEONARD WOOD, Mo. – Did you know that the Maneuver Support Center of Excellence and Fort Leonard Wood can provide a speaker for your community event, group luncheon or organization meeting?

If you are a teacher, a member of a civic organization, a Boy or Girl Scout troop leader, a business executive or a conference organizer looking for someone to talk to your organization, the Fort Leonard Wood Public Affairs Office can help you connect with a subject matter expert.

The process starts with filling out a request form on the Fort Leonard Wood website at http://www.wood.army.mil/newweb/pao/document/Request_forSpeakingEngagement.pdf. Once filled out, scan and email the completed form to usarmy.leonardwood.mscoe.mbx.paoctbrequests@mail.mil or fax to 573.563.4012. Be sure to allow 45 to 60 days advance notice for your request to be reviewed, processed and approved.

Not all events can be supported. Fundraising events, events that are closed to the public, events during a religious service, and events that directly or indirectly endorse a private individual or political candidate are some examples of events that cannot be supported.
