2. GENERAL.

a. I am totally committed to ensuring the success of our military education institutions and our future military leaders who pass through our facilities. Enhancing the professional learning environment and overall quality of life for our incoming military students here at Fort Leonard Wood is one of my highest priorities. Sponsorship programs and support groups are essential to this priority. A successful program must have continual interaction and an ongoing information exchange in order to be effective.

b. This policy applies to all BOLC IMT students permanently or temporarily assigned, attached, or otherwise present on Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri.

3. POLICY AND PROCEDURES.

a. To be combat ready, our Soldiers must be well-trained and healthy, both physically and mentally. To assist Soldiers to achieve and maintain this status, I am directing that all inbound, unaccompanied BOLC IMT students reside on post for better access to the support facilities and programs. These students will then be able to better


utilize the support tools available to avoid, alleviate, or prevent problems before experiencing any undue hardships. Those students who have accompanying dependents will be allowed to reside off post.

b. Commanders and leaders at all levels with command or supervisory responsibility for BOLC IMT officers will ensure that this policy is clearly understood by everyone under their charge.

c. Requests for exception will be routed through the student's chain of command to obtain brigade commander approval.
