## Enduring

- Training a Regiment **READY** to meet the demands of the Army today and beyond (Total Army with our Reserve Army National Guard Counterparts, and DA Civilians)
- A Regiment of Continual Learning and adaptation to the Army Profession

- A capabilities-based Regiment that provides unique **SKILLS** and **TOOLS** the Army needs which only we can deliver in support of Unified Land Operations

## Long Range

- "Organizing for Purpose" across our Military Police Formations
- Codify Forensics as a unique capability and set conditions to train Military Police on its application in support of Unified Land Operations and Rule of Law
- Codify credentialing programs (31B, 31E, 31K)
- Partnering with Special Operations and leveraging training and real world mission opportunities
- Explore advanced material capabilities and solutions that will transition to Programs of Record to enable Military Police to support the Army today and beyond

## Short Range

- Continual refinement of training programs across the spectrum of PME, IMT and Functional Courses (through Critical Task Selection Boards, Lessons Learned, observations from field, guests, learner-centric strategies)
- Achieve standardization across the Force (LE Certification, Training, Equipment, LE Common Operating Picture, AT/FP Capabilities)
- Establish the foundational template for Military Police Future Force Capabilities and Future Force Structure
