SUBJECT: Policy Requiring Locality Per Diem Meal Rates for TDY

1. Effective signature date of this policy, all United States Army Military Police School courses requiring temporary duty (TDY) per diem rates will fall into the locality meal rate for calculation of per diem. Insufficient dining space combined with mission and student requirements compels this decision.
2. The worldwide per diem board can include sister service students in the decision if other similar provisions are not already in force.
3. This policy memorandum supersedes all previously issued policy guidance on this subject.
