SUBJECT: Command Policy # 18, 3rd Chemical Brigade High Risk Range Policy

1. References

- a. AR 385-10, The Army Safety Program
- b. DA Pam 385-10, Mishap Risk Management
- c. FLW Reg 385-10, Safety Program

2. Purpose. Delineation of approval authority for Battalion Commander for the three dictated FLW High risk ranges: Range 4 (Night Infiltration Course), Range 12 (Fire Maneuver Range), and Range 31 (Hand Grenade Range)

3. General. In order to streamline the Composite Risk Management (CRM) process for the brigade, this policy is established to institute baseline risk reduction measures for the three high risk ranges. These baseline risk reduction measures (enclosures) apply to each range, each time it is executed. Battalions and Companies will continue to develop their daily risk assessments to account for current and local conditions. Both risk assessments are required to execute any of the high risk ranges.

4. Responsibilities:

- a. Battalion Commanders.

(1) Implement approved mitigation measures at enclosures for each high risk range.

(2) Develop and approve daily risk assessments taking into account current conditions and approve at least 72 hours prior to the training and reviewed on the day of training.

- b. Brigade Safety

(1) Review risk assessments at least annually.

(2) Ensure compliance with the minimum standards through spot checking risk assessments during range operations.

5. The risk assessment will be valid for a period not to exceed one year from date of this policy and updated as changes in operations occur.
