SUBJECT: Command Policy #19, The Total Army Sponsorship Program (TASP)

1. REFERENCES.

- a. AR 600-8-8, The Total Army Sponsorship Program Dated: 4 April 2006.
- b. HQDA Execution Order 018-012, The Total Army Sponsorship Program.
- c. TRADOC Policy Letter #19, The Total Army Sponsorship Program, (TASP) Dated: 20 January 2012.
- d. MSCoE SOP for the Total Army Sponsorship Program (TASP), for Individuals Assigned or Attached to the Installation, Dated: 29 April 2013

2. PURPOSE. In accordance with TRADOC Policy Letter #19, this memorandum establishes policy, operating procedures, and responsibilities of TASP within the 3rd Chemical Brigade.

3. SCOPE: This policy applies to all permanently assigned personnel (military and civilian), Soldiers attending long-term (20 weeks or more) military schools, and Soldiers graduating from their Advanced Individual Military Training (AIT) enroute to their first permanent duty station.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES: TASP is a commander's program. Sponsors represent the first impression of an organization for newly assigned Soldiers and Civilian employees. Success of the Sponsorship Program is contingent upon the level of involvement by commanders and other leaders within the organization.

- a. Commanders of units within 3rd Chemical Brigade will appoint, in writing, a sponsorship coordinator and an alternate within their organization to execute, supervise, and evaluate TASP.


- b. Commanders will conduct an annual inspection of TASP.

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5. PROCEDURES: TASP Programs at Brigade and Battalion Level will be setup, organized and maintained by the S1 Sections in accordance with MSCoE TASP SOP dated 29 April 2013. Individually appointed sponsors will meet all requirements outlined in Paragraph #6 of the MSCoE TASP SOP when sponsoring inbound personnel.

6. PROPONENCY. The proponent for this command policy is the 3rd Chemical Brigade S-1 at 6-0850.
