## HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT

### **HAZARDOUS WASTE TURN-IN (Refer to the DPW Hazardous Waste Turn-in Management Bulletin at) <http://www.wood.army.mil/DPWENV>**

- Units must coordinate with their Environmental Compliance Officer (ECO) for hazardous waste turn-ins.
- Waste must be turned in to the DRMO Hazardous Property Disposal contractor, building 2229

### **COMMON HAZARDOUS WASTES (Turn-in to DRMO Haz-Waste Disposal Contractor 596-5951)**

- Weapons bore cleaning patches
- Aerosol Cans
- Paint (CARC and Enamel, Lacquer etc.)
- Used Solvents (Methyl Ethyl Ketone, Xylene, Acetone, Toluene, Methylene Chloride etc.)
- Paint Thinner
- Contaminated Fuel (Diesel, Mogas, JP-8)
- Super Tropical Bleach (STB)
- NBC mask filters
- Gas and Aviation gas Filters
- Residue from clean up of HW Spills
- Sodium Hydroxide
- Some Expired Shelf Life Materials (Epinephrine/Bee Sting kits, paint, adhesives, solvents, etc.)

### **WASTES REQUIRING PERIODIC ANALYTICAL TESTING**

- Used Photographic Fixer
- Used Oil
- Weapons cleaning rags, patches and swabs
- Unknown "Orphan" Waste
- Used Parts Washer Solvents and filters
- Sludges
- Contact DPW Environmental at 596-1358 to make arrangements for testing

### **SATELLITE ACCUMULATION POINT (SAP) REQUIREMENTS**

- Location must be approved by DPW Environmental Division, 596-1358
- Must appoint a HW Manager and Alternate
- HW Managers and alternates must be trained in SAP management IAW FLW 200-1
- Containers must be labeled Hazardous Waste, marked with contents and date of first Accumulation, kept closed and in good non-leaking condition. Containers must have secondary containment.
- Must not exceed 55 gallons or one year from start date of accumulation
- Once a container is full or reaches the one year accumulation time limit it must be marked with the date and turned in within 72 Hours (call DRMO Hazardous Property Disposal Contractor at 596-5951).
- Satellite accumulation areas must be clearly marked and secured from unauthorized personnel
- Ignitable and/or reactive wastes must have NO SMOKING sign posted
- Turn-in documents (FLW form 767), must be kept for one year.
- FLW Spill Prevention and Response Plan must be posted at each SAP site.
- Spill clean up kit and fire extinguisher must be maintained at or near SAP site.
- SAP must be inspected periodically by manager, alternate, ECO or Environmental Office Personnel

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## Hazardous Waste Management

### UNIVERSAL WASTES (These hazardous wastes are regulated under the Universal Waste Rule)

#### **Turn-in to DPW Base Maintenance Contractor, 596-4828**

- Fluorescent Bulbs (Green tip bulbs are not hazardous and not regulated)
- Metal Halide and Sodium Vapor Bulbs
- Thermometers, Switches and Thermostats containing Mercury
- Batteries (Nickel Cadmium, Mercury, Lithium, Magnesium)
- Turn-in to DRMO Hazardous Property Disposal Contractor, **596-5951**

### POL PRODUCT WASTES (Refer to the Environmental Bulletin at):

- Used Oil & Oil Filters
- Oily Rags
- Used Dry-Sweep
- POL contaminated soil
- Solvents
- Antifreeze
- Hydraulic, brake, and transmission fluids
- Contaminated gasoline and diesel fuels

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- Yard Waste and Clean Fill material (**Contact the DPW Environmental Branch at 596-1158**)
  - Used Oil, Excess JP-8 or water contaminated diesel fuel from vehicle maintenance or aircraft operations may be picked up by **contacting the DPW Service Order Desk at 596-0333**
  - Lead Acid Batteries from Vehicles (**contact the DOL Battery Shop for Turn-in, 596-4028**)

### HAZARDOUS MATERIAL CONTROL CENTER (HMCC) 596-1162

- List of excess Materials may be turned in to the HMCC for reissue (free to the unit)
- HMCC provides assistance for units managing hazardous materials
- HMCC is an excellent resource for obtaining Material Data Safety Sheets (MSDS)

### SPILL RESPONSE AND REPORTING

- Spills of HW, POL and Hazardous Materials must be managed in accordance with the FLW Spill Prevention and Response Plan.
- CALL 911 (FLW Fire Department) to report ALL spills
- Submit Spill Report to DPW Environmental Division within 3 days of incident
