## PURPOSE

The Military Police Advanced Leader Course provides 31D Noncommissioned Officers with the technical and tactical skills required to successfully serve as Military Police Squad Leaders and Special Agents. The course also enhances the student's ability to lead, train, and direct subordinates in all functional areas of the Military Police Corps and within their specialty.

## COURSE SCOPE

Students will demonstrate proficiency in the Military decision making process, Army effective writing, Military briefings, conducting felony criminal investigation, evidence collection and processing, evidence room procedures, major incident and hostage negotiation operations, and protective service mission support. Student will also take part in community service and a formal dining in which will be evaluated in the contribution to group work portion of their 1059.

## COURSE PREREQUISITES

Active Army or Reserve Component enlisted personnel selected by DA (Active Army) or recommended by unit Commander (Reserve Component). Qualified in CMF 31. Meets requirements outlined in AR 350-1 (para 3-49) and DA Pam 611-21. All Soldiers must have successfully completed Structured Self Development (SSD) II and the Warrior Leader Course (WLC) at least six months before attending this course.
